



Conditions of use

Access to the Kunsthistorisches Institut in Florenz is only possible with valid user ID cards.

Admission cards are issued at the following times (please note our closing days):

Tuesday, 10am - 11am

Wednesday, 2pm - 3pm

Thursday, 10am - 11am

As a general rule, it is necessary to have completed a doctorate in order to be eligible for a user ID card. A **government-issued document** (identity card, passport...), a **letter of recommendation** and a **passport-sized photograph** and a **short outline** of the research project (maximum two pages) must also be submitted with the application.

Graduate students (specialist degree or first level master's degree) are only granted access in exceptional cases and, like doctoral students, they must submit an outline of their thesis project (maximum two pages).
